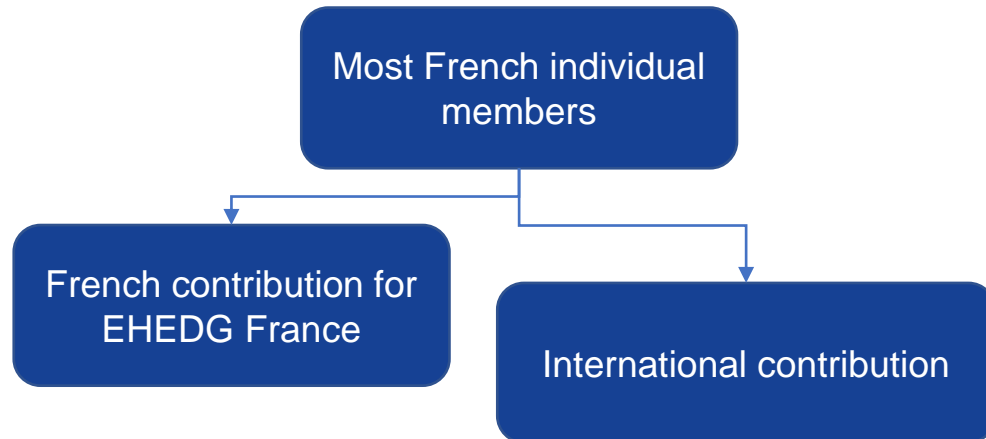
EHEDG France from 2020 to 2022

Exhibition: CFIA trade show and Pch

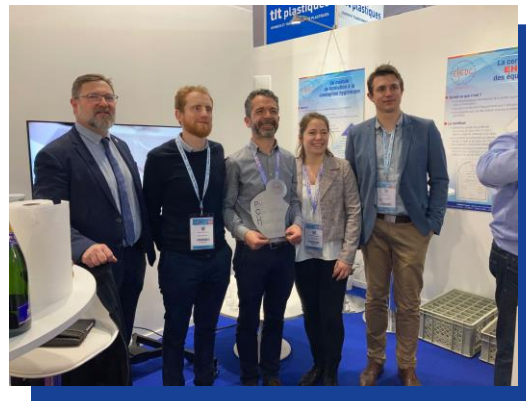


Since 2016

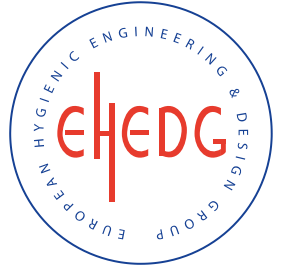

Guidelines translation



EHEDG guidelines (new and revised) are translated into French by specialized translation agencies and reviewed by members of the French EHEDG board.

Since 2020, we have translated 4 documents: N°50, 54, 8 (2018) and 14 (2020).

5 new guidelines should be translated and review in the next months: N°17, 22, 23, 46, 52 and 55.
