Felix Schottroff is assistant professor of food process engineering at the Institute of Food Technology, BOKU University, in Vienna. He holds a B.Sc. from Technical University Berlin and a M.Sc. in Food and Biotechnology from Technical University Munich. Felix received his PhD from BOKU University in 2020, working on novel food processing technologies for microbial inactivation.

In his research, Felix focusses on various novel and non-thermal technologies for microbial inactivation, taking into account inactivation mechanisms, product quality, process and equipment design. Moreover, Felix focusses on the processing of new food raw materials and process chains for their effective conversion, including conventional as well as innovative food processing technologies. In his teaching and research, Felix further covers aspects of cleaning and disinfection, and hygienic design of food processing equipment.

Since 2019, Felix is co-chair of the EHEDG Regional Section Austria and contributed to organize various EHEDG Basic, Advanced, and Special Courses in both German and English Language.



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
